## ***Introduction***

*Life has a way of presenting moments that challenge how we see ourselves,  
how we process our experiences, and how we understand God's role in our story.  
Sometimes those moments leave us carrying emotions we don't fully understand  
questions we don't have answers to, and thoughts we don't always know how to process.*

*The RAP ASSIST Devotional was created to help guide you  
through those moments using the truth of God's Word.  
This is more than a devotional - it is a journey of transformation.  
Over the next 7 days, you will begin a process that moves  
you through a powerful Gospel-centered progression:*

*From Brokenness to Wholeness*

*Each day is designed to help you:*

- Reflect on real-life experiences*
- Engage with Scripture in a personal way*
- Process your thoughts and emotions*
- Seek God through prayer*
- Begin recognizing His work in your life*

*Through this journey, you will begin to see that  
your story is not separate from God's Word.  
It is being shaped by it.*

## ***How to Use This Devotional***

*Each day follows a simple, intentional rhythm called RAP ASSIST:*

### ***Read***

*Start with the Scripture.*

*Allow God's Word to set the foundation for your reflection.*

### ***Apply***

*Reflect on how the Scripture connects to your life.*

*You will be guided through:*

- *A central Idea*
- *Your Thoughts & Feelings*
- *Personal Reflection questions*

### ***Pray***

*Respond to God through prayer.*

*Invite Him into your thoughts, emotions, and experiences.*

### ***Proclaim***

*Speak truth over your life.*

*Begin to align your perspective with what God says about you.*

### ***Your Role in This Journey***

*This devotional is interactive.*

*You are encouraged to:*

- *Write your thoughts honestly*
- *Reflect deeply*
- *Engage with the prompts*
- *Take your time*

*There is no pressure to be perfect – only an invitation to be real.*

*Thank you for taking the time to begin this journey.  
Whether you picked up this devotional out of curiosity, need, or desire for growth,  
your willingness to pause and reflect matters.  
Transformation does not happen all at once.  
It happens in moments like these.*

*Moments where you choose to:*

- *slow down*
- *reflect honestly*
- *seek God intentionally*

*My prayer is that during these 7 days, you begin to see clearly that  
God is present in your story - guiding, restoring, and strengthening you.  
This is only the beginning.*

# Identity in Christ

Knowing Who You Are

*Discovering who you are through God's Word.*

*This week focuses on the truth of your identity in Christ.*

*Each day invites you to reflect on Scripture and respond*

*by writing honestly about your thoughts,*

*emotions, prayers, and spiritual insights.*

# You Are Chosen

## READ

*"But you are not like that, for you are a chosen people. You are royal priests, a holy nation, God's very own possession. As a result, you can show others the goodness of God, for he called you out of the darkness into his wonderful light."*

— 1 Peter 2:9 (NLT)

Before the foundation of the world, God chose you. Not because of your performance, your resume, or your worthiness — but because of His love. Today, let that truth settle into every part of your identity. You are not an accident. You are handpicked by the Creator of the universe.

## APPLY — 25-WORD DECLARATION

***"I am chosen by God, called out of darkness into His marvelous light, and I walk as His royal priesthood today."***

## PROCLAIM — PRAYER

Father, I thank You that I am chosen — not by chance but by Your sovereign love. I confess the times I have lived as if I were forgotten or overlooked. Today I receive my identity as Your special possession. Send me into this day with the confidence of one who is deeply loved. In Jesus' name, Amen.

## Fearfully & Wonderfully Made

### READ

*"Thank you for making me so wonderfully complex! Your workmanship is marvelous — how well I know it."*

— Psalm 139:14 (NLT)

God didn't mass-produce you. He crafted every detail of your being with intentionality and wonder. The enemy wants you to see flaws; God wants you to see a masterpiece. Today, choose to agree with your Maker.

### APPLY — 25-WORD DECLARATION

*"I am fearfully and wonderfully made by God. His works are wonderful, and I am one of them."*

### PROCLAIM — PRAYER

Lord, I praise You for the way You made me. I confess that I have criticized Your craftsmanship when I criticized myself. Thank You for forming me with purpose and precision. Help me to see myself through Your eyes today. Amen.

## A New Creation

### READ

*"This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!"*

— 2 Corinthians 5:17 (NLT)

Your past does not define you — Christ does. The moment you placed your trust in Him, the old version of you was buried. What remains is a new creation, empowered by the Spirit and destined for glory. Stop visiting the graveyard of your old life.

### APPLY — 25-WORD DECLARATION

***"I am a new creation in Christ. The old has gone, the new has come, and I live in that newness today."***

### PROCLAIM — PRAYER

Jesus, I thank You that in You I am made brand new. I confess that I sometimes return to old patterns and old identities. I am grateful that Your mercies are new every morning. Empower me to walk in this newness with boldness and freedom. Amen.

# God's Workmanship

## READ

*"For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago."*

— Ephesians 2:10 (NLT)

You are not random. You are God's masterpiece. And the good works He has for you were planned before you took your first breath. Your purpose is not something you need to invent; it's something you need to discover.

## APPLY — 25-WORD DECLARATION

*"I am God's masterpiece, created in Christ Jesus for good works that He planned for me long ago."*

## PROCLAIM — PRAYER

Father, I worship You as the Master Craftsman. I confess the times I have felt purposeless or insignificant. Thank You for preparing a path of good works for me. Lead me into those assignments today with a willing and obedient heart. Amen.

## No Condemnation

### READ

*"So now there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus."*

— Romans 8:1 (NLT)

Guilt and shame are not from God. The enemy uses condemnation as a weapon, but the cross dismantled it completely. If you are in Christ, the verdict is in: not guilty. Walk in that freedom today.

### APPLY — 25-WORD DECLARATION

*"There is no condemnation for me in Christ Jesus. I am free from guilt and walk in His grace."*

### PROCLAIM — PRAYER

Lord Jesus, I thank You that the cross settled my case forever. I confess that I have carried shame You never intended for me. Thank You that Your grace covers me completely. Help me to silence every voice of condemnation with Your truth. Amen.

## Heir of the Promise

### READ

*"And since we are his children, we are his heirs. In fact, together with Christ we are heirs of God's glory."*

— Romans 8:17 (NLT)

You are not a spiritual orphan scraping for crumbs. You are an heir — a co-heir with Jesus Christ Himself. Everything the Father has promised belongs to you through Christ. Walk into this day with the confidence of royalty.

### APPLY — 25-WORD DECLARATION

***"I am an heir of God and co-heir with Christ. Every promise of the Father belongs to me."***

### PROCLAIM — PRAYER

Abba Father, I come boldly as Your child and heir. I confess that I have lived beneath my inheritance, doubting Your provision. Thank You for adopting me into Your family. Help me to walk in the fullness of what You have promised. Amen.

# The Temple of the Holy Spirit

## READ

*"Don't you realize that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit, who lives in you and was given to you by God?"*

— 1 Corinthians 6:19 (NLT)

The same Spirit that raised Christ from the dead lives inside of you. You are not just a building — you are a temple, a holy dwelling place for the living God. Let that reality transform how you treat yourself and how you move through the world.

## APPLY — 25-WORD DECLARATION

*"My body is a temple of the Holy Spirit. God dwells in me, and I honor Him with all I am."*

## PROCLAIM — PRAYER

Holy Spirit, I welcome Your presence within me. I confess the ways I have dishonored this temple You inhabit. Thank You for choosing to dwell inside me. Help me to live in a way that honors You in thought, word, and deed. Amen.

## **Week 1 — Identity in Christ**

This week invites you to reflect on the foundation of who you are through God's truth.

As you move through the week, notice how Scripture reveals a journey of transformation- from understanding that you are chosen by God to recognizing His Spirit living within you.

Before you did anything to earn it, God chose you.  
His love reaches beyond human standards and invites you  
into a relationship that is rooted in grace. Your identity begins with this truth: you belong to Him.

**Gospel Movement: Identity — God calls you.**

**The Idea**

God has chosen you to belong to Him.  
Write about a moment when you felt accepted or valued.

**The Feelings**

- How does it feel to know that God personally chooses you?
- Do you ever struggle to believe that you truly belong?

**The Prayer**

Lord, thank You for choosing me and calling me Your own.  
Help me to remember that my identity is rooted in You and not in the opinions of others.  
Write a prayer to God in your own words to identify and Him and what He is calling you to do.

**Reflection**

- What experiences have shaped the way you see yourself?
- How might your life change if you fully embraced the truth that you are chosen by God?

You were not created by accident. Every part of who you are reflects God's intentional design. When you begin to see yourself through God's perspective, you start to recognize the value He placed within you.

**Gospel Movement: Worth - God created you with intention.**

**The Idea**

God created you with care and purpose.

Write about something unique about yourself that reflects God's design.

**The Feelings**

- How does it feel to know that God carefully designed you?
- Do you ever compare yourself to others and question your worth?

**The Prayer**

Lord, thank You for creating me with care and purpose.

Help me see myself through Your eyes and appreciate the person You created me to be.

Write a prayer to God in your own words for how He made you His workmanship.

**Reflection**

- What part of yourself do you sometimes struggle to accept?
- How might your perspective change if you saw yourself through God's truth?

Your past does not define you—Christ does. Through Him,  
God offers a fresh beginning where the old life no longer determines your future.

**Gospel Movement: Renewal - God gives you a new life.**

**The Idea**

Through Christ, God gives you a new beginning.  
Write about an area of your life where you desire a fresh start.

**The Feelings**

- How does it feel to know that God offers new beginnings?
- Are there parts of your past that are difficult to release?

**The Prayer**

Lord, thank You for the new life I have in Christ.  
Help me release the weight of my past and embrace the future You are shaping for me.  
Write a prayer to God in your own words for how He feel about being made new in Christ Jesus.

**Reflection**

- What old habits or thoughts do you want to leave behind?
- What would it look like to step into the new life God is offering you?

God created you with intention and purpose.  
Your life is not random; it is part of a greater story God is writing.

**Gospel Movement: Purpose - God designed your life with meaning.**

**The Idea**

God created you with purpose and intention.  
Write about a gift, passion, or opportunity that may reveal God's purpose in your life.

**The Feelings**

- How does it feel to know that your life has purpose?
- Do you ever struggle to see how your life fits into God's plan?

**The Prayer**

Lord, thank You for designing my life with purpose.  
Guide me as I seek to understand the work You have prepared for me.  
Write a prayer to God in your own words asking Him to identify your life's purpose.

**Reflection**

- What talents or interests might God be using to guide your purpose?
- What step could you take toward discovering that purpose?

God's grace releases you from the weight of shame.  
Through Christ, forgiveness replaces guilt and freedom replaces condemnation.

**Gospel Movement: Freedom — God's grace removes shame.**

**The Idea**

In Christ, you are free from condemnation.  
Write about something from your past you may still struggle to forgive yourself for.

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**The Feelings**

- What emotions arise when you think about that memory?
- Do feelings of guilt sometimes hold you back?

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**The Prayer**

Lord, thank You for the forgiveness You offer through  
Christ. Help me release the shame and guilt I have been carrying.  
Write a prayer to God in your own words about the guilt you are no longer carrying.

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**Reflection**

- What thoughts continue to bring feelings of guilt or regret?
- What would it look like to accept God's grace fully?

God's grace releases you from the weight of shame.  
Through Christ, you are welcomed into God's family.  
You are no longer an outsider - you belong to Him.

**Gospel Movement: Belonging — You are part of God's family.**

**The Idea**

As God's child, you share in His promises.  
Write about what it means to you to be part of God's family.

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**The Feelings**

- How does it feel to know you belong to God?
- Do you ever struggle to believe you are worthy of His love?

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**The Prayer**

Father, thank You for welcoming me into Your family.  
Help me remember that I belong to You and share in Your promises.  
Write a prayer to God in your own words about how you feel as being a child of God.

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**Reflection**

- How does knowing you belong to God change how you see yourself?
  - What promise from God gives you encouragement today?
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God's Spirit lives within you. You are never alone,  
and His presence guides and strengthens you each day.

**Gospel Movement: Presence — God's Spirit lives within you.**

**The Idea**

God's Spirit lives within you.

Write about a moment when you sensed God's presence guiding or strengthening you.

**The Feelings**

- How does it feel to know God's Spirit lives within you?
- When do you feel most aware of His presence?

**The Prayer**

Lord, thank You for placing Your Spirit within me.

Help me listen for Your guidance and live in a way that honors Your presence.

Write a prayer to God in your own words about living out the life with the His Spirit that lives in you.

**Reflection**

- How can you become more aware of God's presence each day?
- What is one way you can honor God with your life today?

# Your Journey Continues

Over the past seven days, you have taken time to pause, reflect on Scripture, and consider how God's Word speaks into the experiences of your life.

Moments like these are often where growth begins.

When we slow down and reflect on God's truth, we begin to see our lives differently. We recognize His presence in the situations we face, His guidance in the decisions we make, and His grace working through the challenges we encounter.

This 7-Day Sample is drawn from the larger **RAP ASSIST: 31-Day Devotional**, which continues this journey of reflection and Scripture-centered growth.

The full devotional explores four important themes that help deepen our understanding of God's work in our lives:

## **Week 1 – Identity in Christ**

Discover the foundation of who you are through God's truth.

## **Week 2 – Peace & Surrender**

Learn to trust God and find peace in His presence during uncertain moments.

## **Week 3 – Purpose & Calling**

Explore how God equips and guides us to live out His purpose.

## **Week 4 – Boldness & Proclamation**

Grow in confidence as you share your faith and the story of what God is doing in your life.

Each day continues the RAP ASSIST rhythm: Read. Apply. Proclaim.

These daily reflections are designed to help you recognize how God's Word speaks into the everyday experiences that shape your life.

Whether you continue this journey on your own, with a small group, or in a teaching setting, our hope is that the full devotional will provide ongoing encouragement as you grow in faith.

As you continue exploring God's Word, may you discover new insights, deeper understanding, and greater confidence in the story He is writing through your life.

## **A Final Encouragement**

Your story matters.

The moments you reflect on today may one day become the testimony that encourages someone else tomorrow. Continue seeking God's wisdom, listening for His guidance, and walking forward in faith.

## **Appendix A — The RAP ASSIST Framework**

### **Read • Apply • Proclaim**

The RAP ASSIST Framework is a simple, intentional way to engage with God's Word so that it connects directly to your life.

It is designed to help you move beyond just reading Scripture into understanding, applying, and living it out.

#### **READ - Start with God's Word**

Every transformation begins with truth.

As you read the Scripture for the day, take your time.

Let the words settle in your heart and mind.

You are not just reading for information - you are reading for revelation. Ask yourself: What is God saying in this Scripture? What stands out to me?

#### **APPLY - Connect the Word to Your Life**

This is where Scripture becomes personal.

Through guided prompts, you are invited to reflect on:  
your experiences, your thoughts, your emotions.

This step helps you see how God's Word speaks directly into your situation.

This includes:

The Idea (truth from Scripture)

- Your Thoughts & Feelings
- Guided Reflection Questions

You are encouraged to be honest. There is no need to filter your responses.

#### **PRAY - Invite God Into Your Process**

Prayer is your response to what you have read and reflected on.

This is where you: release what you are carrying, ask for guidance and invite God into your situation.

Prayer turns reflection into relationship.

#### **PROCLAIM - Speak Truth Over Your Life**

What you speak shapes what you believe.

In this step, you begin to align your voice with God's truth.

Instead of repeating fear, doubt, or past experiences,  
you begin to declare what God says.

This is where transformation begins to take root.

## **Appendix B — Understanding the Gospel Movement From Brokenness to Bold Faith**

The Gospel Movement is the journey that God takes us on as  
He transforms our lives through His Word.  
It reminds us that we are not stuck—we are moving.

### **The Transformation Path**

From Brokenness » Wholeness » Trust » Purpose » Bold Faith

Each step represents a shift that happens as we grow in our relationship with God.

#### **Brokenness**

We all begin with experiences that shape how we think, feel, and see ourselves.  
This can include: pain, confusion, fear, and doubt.  
Brokenness is not the end of your story - it is often where God begins His work.

#### **Wholeness**

Through God's Word, healing begins. You start to: see yourself differently,  
release what you've been carrying, and receive God's truth  
Wholeness does not mean perfection. It means restoration is taking place.

#### **Trust**

As healing begins, you learn to trust God more deeply.  
You begin to: release control, surrender your worries, and believe that  
God is working in your life  
Trust is built through consistent connection with God.

#### **Purpose**

As your perspective changes, clarity begins to form.  
You start to recognize: your gifts, your direction, your role in God's plan  
Purpose is not something you create - it is something you discover.

#### **Bold Faith**

As you grow, your faith becomes visible.  
You begin to:  
speak truth with confidence  
live out what you believe  
share your story with others  
Bold faith is the result of a life shaped by God's Word.
